

## **Frequently Asked Questions:**

**If I do not apply to live in Mayer, would I still be able to participate in T2 programs?** Yes, all sophomores are eligible to participate in T2 sponsored programs, events and services regardless of where they live on-campus.

**I know I am required to reside on-campus for two years, but do I have to apply for this housing option?** No, you do not have to apply for residency in the T2 community at Mayer. Information on other housing options will be available online in late February.

**If selected to live in Mayer, when and how will I select a room?** Room selection will be completed online following Spring Break. Those selected to live in Mayer will be given a randomly generated time to login and select their room (details forthcoming).

**Can I obtain a single room in Mayer?** There are a limited number of single rooms available and can be selected through the online room selection process. Roughly 25% of Mayer Residences is 2-person suites (single room sharing a restroom with a single room). Roughly 75% of Mayer is 4-person suites (double room sharing a restroom with a double room).

**Can I pick my roommate and suitemates?** Yes, as long as they have applied to and been accepted into Mayer T2 along with you! You are strongly encouraged to select your roommate and suitemates!

**If I apply but do not get accepted, where will I live?** Rising sophomores who are not accepted into Mayer's community will be automatically placed into the housing selection process for all other rising sophomores. That selection process will occur after Spring Break with information scheduled to be sent out later in February to all current freshmen.

**I live in Wall currently; can I apply to return to Wall AND apply to live in Mayer?** Yes, but you should not submit your application to Mayer until AFTER the Wall Returning announcements are distributed on February 25, 2008.

**I do not live in Wall currently, but am interested in applying to the Wall Residential College. Can I apply to Wall AND apply to Mayer T2 at the same time?** You may submit an individual application for both processes. However, if you are selected to both areas, you will have to accept one of the offers within 48 hours of receiving the notifications. Acceptance of an offer will automatically remove you from the other process completely. Notification to all applicants (either accepted or not) will be distributed on Monday, March 10, 2008.
